



IQLA MEMBERSHIP

IQLA membership is annual, renewable in December of each year. If you join IQLA at any time during the year, you will become a member for that year. Unless you cancel membership until November 31 of that year, membership is automatically prolonged for the subsequent year; in this case, membership renewal is not necessary. As a full member, you will receive all *Journal of Quantitative Linguistics* issues, including back issues, for the current year (i.e., the complete volume). Arrears for up to two years prior must be paid to prolong or renew membership.

Each IQLA membership is valid for one full calendar year from the date of receipt of payment. This means your membership will be activated January 1 following the date your application form and payment are received, and will expire 365 days later, unless renewed before expiration.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Full Professional membership

Professional memberships apply to all members who are post education and/or no longer in a post-doctoral training position.

Supporting Professional Membership

Supporting professional memberships apply to all members who are post education and/or no longer in a post-doctoral training position, but who do not want to include subscription of the *Journal of Quantitative linguistics*.

Post Doctoral Membership

Post Doctoral memberships are available to members in post-doctoral training positions.

Student (Predoc) Membership

Student memberships are available to all full-time students. A Student member must be a full time student in an academic program.

Special Rules

An Emeritus member must be retired, due to age or illness, from professional employment, and to have been an active member of the IQLA for at least ten years.

New and returning professional members who are unemployed at the time of registration may submit a request for approval to register at the Student rate within the corresponding residence dues category (see below) for one year (eventually to be prolonged).

MEMBERSHIP DUES

Membership dues are differentiated according to member's place of residence and categorized as H (High), M (Middle), or L (Low) according the [World Bank List of Economies](#), as published in 2006. Full Professional (H) includes free subscription of the *Journal of Quantitative Linguistics*. Dues are given in Euro (€).
