The ninth International Conference on Quantitative Linguistics will be held from August 24 until 27 in Trier, Germany. The conference series was established in 1991 in Trier and returns now after 8 conferences in Moscow, Russia, Helsinki, Finland, Prague, Czechia, Athens, Georgia (USA), Graz, Austria, Belgrade, Serbia, and Olomouc, Czechia to Trier.

QUALICO will take place in the conference rooms of the ERA (Europäische Richterkademie, Academy of European Law). Registered participants can find accommodation in the adjacent Hotel.

We expect 60 participants from 16 countries and 3 continents (America, Asia, Europe) with presentations on all the fields of quantitative linguistics.

On occasion of the conference, as usual, the business meeting of the IQLA will be held. All members of our association are free to stand for a position in the council if interested.

III. Glottometrics in “Web of Science” (Thomson Reuters)

The Journal *Glottometrics* (published by RAM-Verlag) was invited by Thomson Reuters to take part in its new Emerging Sources Citations Index (ESCI) (started in November 2015).
